

Look for these endangered animals:

#### **Giant tortoises**

These animals can live from 100 to 150 years. They're the biggest tortoises in the world. They eat fruit and plants. They're endangered because in the past sailors and today goats to them.



endangered because they can't find food, because there are chemicals in the ocean, and because other animals eat their eggs.

#### Iquanas

e guanas are big lizards. They're smaller than giant tortoises, but bigger than dogs. They climb plants and eat the fruits. Some iguanas are endangered here because wild cats and dogs eat them or their eggs.
